ArborMaster modules are designed to provide a graduated, systematic approach, building on the knowledge and skills necessary to advance to the next level.

Level 1 Tree Climbing & Level 1 Precision Felling & Chainsaw Handling do not have pre-requisites other than employment working in and around trees (see Eligibility).

However, our Level 1 Arborist Rigging and our Level 2 modules do have pre-requisites and field experience/skill building requirements.

Why pre-requisites before moving on to more advanced modules?

We want you to be safe and to excel!

It is our experience that in order to achieve this, a key component is to build on a firm foundation of skill, knowledge and industry best practices, through a graduated, systematic approach.

Even students with many years of experience have reported learning many valuable techniques and that they were "humbled at how much there was still to learn".

Why experience & skill building before moving on to more advanced modules?

We want you to be safe and to excel!

In our experience, if a student has little or no prior field experience and has not had the time to build on skills learned in our L1 Climbing and L1 Precision Felling modules, he/she may be putting themselves at risk to move on too quickly to any of our advanced modules.

We don't want you to waste your valuable time or your money if you are not yet prepared to learn more advanced techniques and methods. It's that simple.

Registration Information

Course Outlines: For course outlines, what to bring and where to stay, visit our website at www.ArborMaster.com or call 860.429.5028.

Registration: Please try to register at **least 30 days** in advance of a class. Classes are expected to fill, however if minimum numbers are not met 30 days prior, the course(s) may be rescheduled or cancelled. Full payment is due at time of registration to confirm your space in the class, however will not be processed or deposited until 30 days prior to the start of the program. Space is limited and is based on first come, first serve basis.

Eligibility: Participants must be at least the age of majority and hold full time employment working in and around trees as an arborist, in a hands-on role supporting arborists, or other related role in which you use arborist equipment on a regular basis. Courses not offered to individuals who do not work in an arborist or supporting arborist capacity nor private homeowners or for recreational tree climbing purposes.

Release: Upon receipt of your registration, a participant release form will be sent to you. Cancellation rules apply, and refusal to sign a release form on Day 1 may result in your forfeiting all or part of your registration fee, unless the course(s) are cancelled at least 30 days in advance.

Cancel Policy: Up to 30 days: Full refund; 29-14 days: 50% cancel penalty; 13-0 days: 100% cancel penalty; No-shows: No refund.

...you would like to sign on for more than L1C & L1PF in one visit.

At select locations, we schedule advanced courses back to back with our L1 Climbing and L1 Precision Felling modules. While taking more than 4 days of classes in a row is a lot of information to absorb in a short time, some students desire to take several courses offered in one visit.

Therefore if you would like to stay on for additional courses in Colorado this fall, and in order for us to best determine if you have the prior level of field experience to do so, we ask that you would please:

- 1) Review the following criteria
- 2) Check off which advanced courses you would like to sign on for and we will follow up to learn of your current skill level

Criteria for taking more than L1C & L1PF in one visit

- a) At least 1 year prior field experience. If less than a year, practice and build on skills learned in L1 Climbing and L1 Precision Felling for at least 6 months.
- b) If a student has a year or more field experience in climbing and felling and has taken L1C and L1PF, we may allow them to stay on for advanced courses, based on experience level and review by ArborMaster.

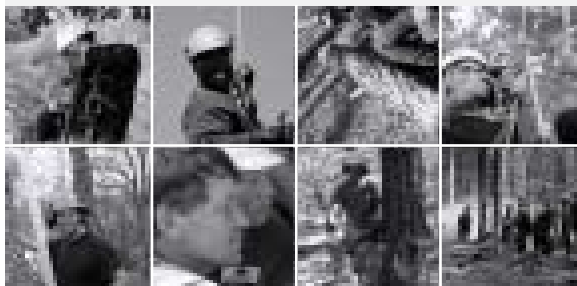
